TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The Promoter is SNA E Australia (A division of Snap-On Tools Australia Pty Ltd - ABN 55 010 793 683), Unit 2 / 7 Cattle Way Gregory Hills, NSW 2557 Australia.
2. Entry into this promotion is deemed as acceptance of the following terms and conditions.
3. Offer is open to residents of Australia and New Zealand aged 18 and above. All employees of the Promoter are ineligible to participate.

THE PROMOTIONAL PERIOD
